#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE LOGBOOK FORM

Start a new logbook page for every trip. Please fill out a new line for each day of fishing effort; each page can be used for up to 4 days of fishing effort. Do not combine multiple trips on a single logbook page. Complete each column on the form by circling the appropriate selection or entering the appropriate information. **INSERT THE FOLDED FLAP OF THE BACK COVER UNDER THE YELLOW COPY OF THE SHEET BEING WRITTEN ON.** This will prevent the entries from being transferred to the underlying sheets. Sign and date each sheet that is submitted.

#### **TOP OF THE PAGE**

Enter the Vessel Name, Coast Guard Document Number or State Registration Number, Captain's Name and License Number, Identify if the Trip was Observed, Departure and Arrival Ports, Departure and Arrival Dates

#### LANDING INFORMATION:

Enter the Port Landed, Unload Date, Pounds Landed (including those kept for personal use), Species, and Landing Receipt Number

#### FISHING EFFORT:

## FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL DAY ENTER STANDARD (UNLINKED BUOYS) GEAR IN THE TOP WHITE LINE AND LINKED GEAR IN THE SECOND GRAY LINE.

Enter the Date of fishing, latitude/longitude in degrees and minutes, number of deployed hooks and pieces (pieces defined as a single linked or a single unlinked buoy), number of hours that the gear was soaked in the water, number of fish kept and number of fish released for each corresponding species (if species not listed use "other" and fill in species name), night-set (circle 'Y' if the set was made at night), comments on anything of note. \*\*\*please note that only fish caught using deep-set or night-set buoy gear should be recorded here and you must fill out the appropriate logbooks for your catch from other gears (i.e. species caught with hook and line gear should be recorded in the hook and line logbook)\*\*\*
